River Room Art Exhibition Saturday 1st September to Saturday 20th October 2018

Introduction

You are invited to contribute 1 item of work of small or medium size so that 30 items can be accommodated. Work needs to be suitable for wall hanging or suspension. A sales commission of 30% will be taken of which 25% + VAT to PFT and 5% to POS. Should an item sell and be taken by a visitor who wishes to take it away immediately, the artist will be contacted and given the opportunity to replace it.

Because of the nature of the display area, it is not possible to have sculptures, ceramics, or any item which cannot be displayed on a wall. This also prohibits cards but up to 3 prints per artist may be submitted so long as each has a title and a price clearly displayed.

Stage One:

1. Your name
2. An indication of the size of the exhibit (width x height x depth) Your item must have a label tied to it with a piece of string long enough to hang over the front. Please ensure that the information on the label is the same as the information you submitted.
3. The title of your work and the sale price along with the medium used.
- 4 Any relevant information to be displayed alongside, e.g. a poem if that inspired the work
5. Your bank details so that PFT can pay any sales income direct to your account.

The Deadline for this information reaching Kate is 5.00pm on Friday 10th of August. If you don't get your information to her by this time then your work will not be entered.

Stage Two

Delivery of Exhibits

Delivery must be made directly to Margaret Pirnie at Pitlochry Festival Theatre on **Monday 27th August between 10.00 am and 4.00pm.**

On delivery you will be asked to unpack your work and take all packaging materials away with you. Items should be prepared ready to hang on the wall, with medium to large sized "D" rings.

Your item must have a label tied to it by a piece of string long enough to hang over the top and be seen at the front and needs to have the following information.

- 1 Name of artist
- 2 Title of piece

3 Medium

4The Sale Price

Labels for exhibits will be produced in PFT/POS house style, using the information you are asked to provide.

Stage Three

Collection must be made from Pitlochry Festival Theatre **on Monday 22nd October from 10.00am-4.00pm**. If that is impossible for you, please contact Margaret Pirnie on 01796 484626, giving at least one week's notice to make alternative arrangements. When you do pick up your work, please have some bubble wrap with you. The Theatre doesn't keep a supply!
